APPELLATION: An area north of Lodi near Acampo, California

VARIETAL: 100% estate-grown Pinot Noir.

TECHNICAL DATA: Partial barrel aged (neutral barrels) and partial tank aged. RS .07 g/L, TA 3.9 g/L, pH 3.01.

ALCOHOL: 13.5%

TASTING NOTES: This wine has a plush core of black cherry, cola and fleshy strawberry. Complex and balanced with classic Pinot Noir characteristics. You will find that hints of earth and flavors of toasted oak round out the finish.
