APPELLATION: Paso Robles, California

VARIETAL: 98% Chardonnay, 2% Albarino

VINEYARD: Like many of our wines we are not allowed to disclose the specific vineyard/winery where the grapes were grown. In order for us to be able to deliver this kind of sub appellation quality at steep discounts, we must often sign non disclosure agreements with the vineyards. * This '16 Paso Robles Chardonnay came from a small historic winery on the west side of Paso Robles. We also blended approximately 2% of Albarino which added an interesting mineral element to this wine.

COOPERAGE: Predominately tank aged with 10% in lightly toasted new French oak barrels.
