

VINTAGE: 2013

APPELLATION: Alexander Valley, California

VARIETAL: Meritage, a Bordeaux style blend of Merlot/ Cab Franc/ Cab Sauvignon.

VINEYARDS: Like many of our wines we are not allowed to disclose the specific vineyard/winery where the grapes were grown. In order for us to be able to deliver the kind of sub appellation quality at the steep discounts, we must often sign non disclosure agreements with the vineyards.

*All the Merlot and Cab Franc came from a single vineyard on the eastern slopes of Alexander Valley. The 4% Cab Sauvignon came from Livermore, California.

TECHNICAL DATA: Predominately barrel aged French oak, 15% new and tank aged. RS .7 g/L, TA 4.43.

ALCOHOL: 14.1%

TASTING NOTES: This Alexander Valley Meritage shows aromas of plum, and cherry. It has concentrated flavors of chocolate, black pepper and vanilla. The wine finishes in a rich lingering fashion.
