The rich minerals from the river valley, the western sun exposure of the vineyards and the seasonal fog make for an ideal growing climate. The soil is a mixture of sand and minerals deposited by the river valley.

Cooperage: Primarily stainless steel tanks with the use of lightly toasted French oak

staves.
